LOGISTICS

In the daily life, the internship students will be based at the training ground together with the academy or first team. Besides the daily activities in the club, the intern will attend a local sports school, where the intern will get UEFA C coaching courses and learn about FCM style-of-play, different football specialist areas, Danish football culture etc.

It will be an advantage if the internship student is fluent in English, both orally and in writing, appreciates an informal tone and has knowledge and is curious about the performance part of the football industry.

The internship position is non-paid, but FC Midtjylland will cover board and lodging. All interns are living in the IBF Arena (single rooms) next to FC Midtjyllands training ground. The start date of the internship positions is asap.
